

TOWN OF GOSHEN
WATER USE ALERT POLICY
Adopted May 2003

Effective May 2003, the Town Board of the Town of Goshen instituted a water use alert program applicable to all persons and parties utilizing the public water supply in the water districts known as Arcadia Hills, Hambletonian Park and, Stone Hedge. This also applies to the Scotchtown district. This information will also be posted on the Town of Goshen website: townofgoshen.org.

The Water and Sewer Commissioner has been authorized to make a determination regarding the category in effect based upon current conditions. Penalties may be imposed against those who violate this policy.

CATEGORY 1: - (RED) All Outdoor Water Use Is Prohibited

CATEGORY 2: (BLUE) Hand-Held Watering Is Allowed
(Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday & Sunday
from daylight to 8:00 pm only)

The following activities are conditionally permitted during BLUE Category:

- Manual watering of outdoor plantings and lawns. Only hand-held hoses or watering cans may be used. Sprinkling devices are prohibited
- Non-commercial washing of cars and other vehicles

CATEGORY 3: (NO NOTICE) Unrestricted Water Use
